



ever-changing environment. Conditions change from one day to the next and sometimes may occur at a more rapid pace, changing hourly. One day you may

be riding hard with the friends the next day you may be site seeing and taking it easy. What is going to keep you comfortable through all these changes? The ability to adapt to the conditions insures comfort for you.

Adaptation is made possible through a layering system. With the layering system one of the key elements is

s a Snowmobiler you find yourself in an | that the outer most piece does not carry insulation. Insulation is provided by separate and individual layers that can be easily taken off or added to depending on the changing conditions and level of activity (30 below or 30 above we have you covered).

> With our layering system you will be able to remove the moisture that builds up in the inside and keep the moisture that is on the outside from coming while maintaining your level of comfort.

There are three components to the layering system and each works together to create a complete system.

- BASE LAYER
- MID WEIGHT LAYER
- OUTER LAYER

LAYER 1: BASE LAYER

The first layer needs to keep you warm and dry on the inside. And since it's closest to the skin, this means long underwear that's soft and lightweight not itchy or bulky, as wool tends to be. Cotton isn't good either, and just like wool, it dries slowly and keeps moisture buildup next to the skin. Synthetic fibers like polypropylene, fleece and polyester are comfortable and dry quickly as they pull moisture away from your skin toward the next layer, where it can evaporate.

LAYER 2: MID-WEIGHT

As the temperature drops or you begin to get chilled, the key to staying warm is ensuring that you are well insulated against the cold. Ideally, the insulator should trap warm air while allowing moisture to escape. Each layer should be lightweight. When layering, add as many layers as is needed to beat the cold. When it warms up or your level of activity increases, just take off a layer. Make sure that the garments are easy to take on and off. Individuals who run at a hotter temperature are often happy with the Inferno Shirt and Pant for insulation.



Klīm's Mid-Weight Layer:

Our Mid-Weight Line-up consists of our fleece pant, jacket and vest. All three piece provide excellent warmth without the unneeded bulk and are made from synthetic fabrics which will not hold onto moisture.



LAYER 3: OUTER LAYER

The outer layer is your best defense against the elements. Jackets and pants should be totally waterproof and windproof but also allow perspiration vapor to vent. This layer reduces heat loss and assists the other layers at keeping the rider dry and comfortable. There are several performance fabrics available but only one carries the Gore-Tex® label. When selecting size make sure the shell is large enough to fit over the other layers. Be sure to consider your activity and the level of protection you'll need. Backcountry winter activities come with a certain element of risk and spending the night in the elements is not uncommon. Be prepared!

Gore-Tex®:

Gore-Tex® is the membrane that is laminated to a surface fabric. It is an extremely thin, lightweight membrane that is the most waterproof and breathable fabric available at any cost today. Gore-Tex® fabric is durably waterproof and will remain waterproof for years, even after laundering, flexing or abrasion.


The Gore-Tex® membrane features an advanced composite made of two different polymers. One is a membrane containing more than 9 billion microscopic pores per square inch. These pores let water vapor from perspiration escape, while keeping out water such as rain. Integrated into the structure is a second polymer that prevents that penetration of contaminating substances such as gasoline, oils, cosmetics, insect repellents and food substances.

"Breathable" means that perspiration vapor is transported away from your body and out through your clothing, keeping you dry on the inside. Breathability is just as important to comfort as waterproofness.
